## BACKGROUND INFORMATION

The Character Development Program uses the stories of Medal of Honor Recipients and Citizen Heroes to teach the values of integrity, courage, commitment, sacrifice, citizenship, and patriotism through age-appropriate, academically-based lessons for grades K-12. The data in this snapshot is the result of teacher surveys to program users, through the 2020- 2021 school year.

## PROGRAM REACH:

- Distributed over 86,000 copies of curriculum since 2009
- Trained over 18,000 teachers in person or online since 2009
- Received over 31,000 webinar views since 2009
- Held 405 training sessions across 44 states plus DC since 2010
- Saw over 25,000 lesson views since new website launch in July 2020



98% of survey respondents would recommend the in-person training to other educators




96% of survey respondents have shared or plan to share the materials with their colleagues





### HELPED REINFORCE CORE SUBJECT SKILLS

### DEMONSTRATING CORE VALUES




Are your students demonstrating the core values in their relationships with other students?


